



# ReadMe for the file “DataSourcesOnRacism.csv”

## How to open the file

The file contains a separator statement (sep=,) and should open correctly in Excel. If this is not the case, please try the following:

- Download the file and save it on your computer
- Open a new Excel sheet
- Go to “Data”
- Choose “From Text/CSV”
- Import the downloaded file
- A new window opens and displays the entries
- Make sure “Comma” is set as the Delimiter
- Click “Load”

## Column descriptions

<b>Resource Type</b>	Type of resource  Categories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Project</li><li>- Datasets</li><li>- Data Journalism</li><li>- Data Aggregator</li></ul>
<b>Title</b>	Title of the resource
<b>Description</b>	Description of the resource
<b>Compiler</b>	Organization that collected or compiled the data/resource



<b>Project Link</b>	Link to the resource
<b>Data Link</b>	Link to the data (if available)
<b>Link for technical documentation / cautions</b>	Information or link to information that describes the resource/data in more detail.
<b>Link for Articles/Discussion</b>	Material about the resource which may help better understand the data/resource.
<b>Restrictions?</b>	Some data may be restricted in use. This could mean that the data are available only through member organizations, only after creating an account, or the user needs to meet certain conditions to use sensitive data.
<b>Geographic Coverage</b>	Geographic area that is covered
<b>Geographic levels</b>	Division of statistical geographic data that is available  Categories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Country</li><li>- Region</li><li>- State/province</li><li>- County</li><li>- Metropolitan area</li><li>- Municipality</li><li>- Community</li></ul>
<b>Date Coverage</b>	Time span that is covered
<b>Data Type</b>	Indicates the type of the data, for example text or GIS
<b>Added/Updated When</b>	Date when entry was added or last updated
<b>Theme</b>	Overall theme of the resource Current themes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Economics</li><li>● Imprisonment</li><li>● Indigenous Peoples</li><li>● Discrimination</li><li>● Youths</li><li>● Civil Rights</li><li>● Hate Crimes</li><li>● Social Justice</li></ul>

<b>Sub-themes (several columns)</b>	One resource can have more than one theme. The themes (previous column) were used to create dummy variables and indicate further sub-themes of the resource.
<b>Keywords</b>	Keywords assigned by members of the IASSIST Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Interest Group, based on the <a href="#">ICPSR Subject Thesaurus</a>
