## Regional Report Europe 2022

- Increased focus on the Horizon Europe EU's new Framework Programme 2021-2027 with a total budget of €95.5 billion to support science and widening the European reseach area.
  - Development of the <u>EOSC European Open Science Cloud</u> is the corner stone
  - CESSDA acts as a bridge builder for inviting data archives, repositories and other partners in
- Realising the Social Sciences and Humanities for the European Open Science Cloud
  - The EU ESFRI Cluster project 'SSHOC Social Sciences and Humanities Open Cloud' is ending and succeeded in transforming the SSH data landscape with its disciplinary silos and separate facilities into an integrated, cloud-based network of interconnected data infrastructures.
  - SSHOC will be transformed into the <u>Social Science and Humanties Open Cluster</u>: The SSH Open Cluster will intensify collaboration between different SSH community stakeholders while actively promoting the quality and impact of SSH within the European Research communities and beyond.
    - The SSH Open Cluster is supported by SSHOC Memorandum of Understanding
  - CESSDA is leading partner in SSHOC project and in the SSHOC Open Cluster
- The European research infrastructure CESSDA ERIC is continuously expanding. Newest member is Ireland
- The <u>Core Trust Seal</u> offers to any interested data repository a core level certification based on the <u>DSA-WDS Core Trustworthy Data</u>
  <u>Repositories Requirements</u> catalogue and procedures.
  - To date 111 CTS certifications are issued for repositories in Europe. Data archives are well-represented.
- Covid-19 has indeed showed the need for data sharing in Europe and beyond
  - CESSDA has (through the CESSDA Service Providers) gathered <u>Resources on COVID-19</u> for researchers and institutions investigating the pandemic.
- The FAIR Principles are still 'trending' and support for implementation is raising e.g. requirements for FAIR for HE applications
  - The initiative GO FAIR and the project FAIRsFAIR 2019-2022 and FAIR-IMPACT 2022-2025 are some of the key players for supporting FAIR uptake and implementations in Europe whether it is individually, locally, nationally and internationally
